List of abbreviations

C Credit

Credits are based on the European credit Transfer System (ECTS). The Bachelor's degree consists of 180 credits and the Master's degree of 120 credits. The only exception is the Master of Psychology degree, which consists of 150 credits. The extent of the Licentiate in Medicine degree is 360 credits and the Licentiate in Dentistry degree 300, or 330 credits. The normative yearly amount of studies is 60 credits, thus the Bachelor's degree can be completed in three academic years and the Master's degree in two.

Lectures, assignments, and other forms of instruction as well as independent study are included in the approximate amount of 27 hours required for one credit.
