# ***Tver Model UN 2019***

## **Human Rights Council**

**W**ithin the framework of the VII Tver International Model of the UN, meetings of the Human Rights Committee were opened. This year, delegates will try to address the complex and urgent problem - of Israel's human rights violations in Lebanon during the second Lebanese war. The Committee meeting was opened by the speech of Murad Sadygzade, the President of the Russian Middle East Association. He gave an independent assessment of the conflict



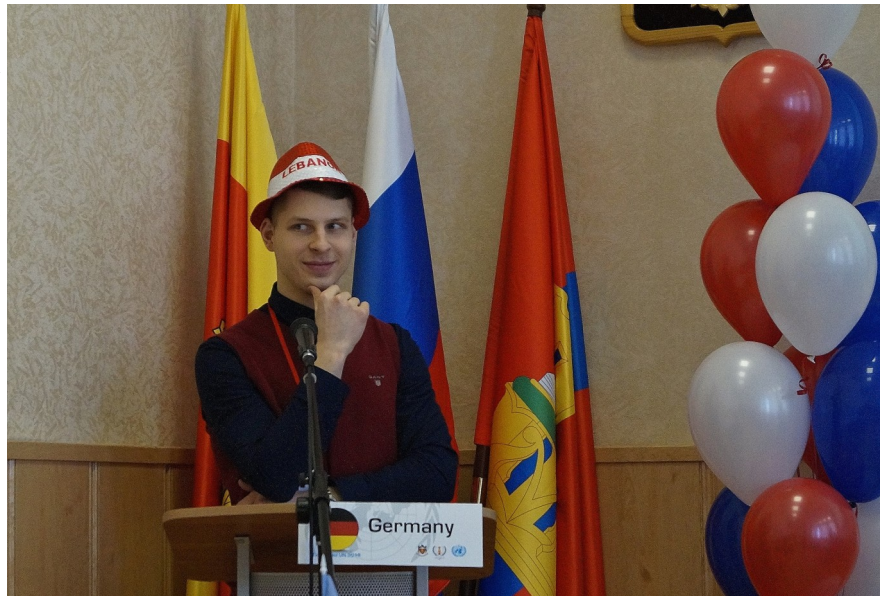
between Lebanon and Israel and also responded to the questions. After that, delegates started to present their position and suggested ways out of the situation. The meeting was attended by representatives of 12 countries: Argentina, Brazil, China,

France, Iran, Saudi Arabia, the Russian Federation, Israel, Lebanon, Libya, Germany and Ukraine. Some representatives supported Lebanon and showed great sympathy for its citizens. Some of them took the side of Israel, arguing that the most important thing is to get rid of Hezbollah terrorism. There were also those who decided to stay away from the conflict and its outcomes.

For example, a delegate from China proclaimed that his country had enough inner policy's issues which needed to be resolved immediately. That's why China could not seek solutions to the problem of human rights violation.

This position provoked a strong reaction from the rest of the delegates. Unlike the modest speech of the delegate from Iran.

It is worth noting that the delegate from Lebanon was bravely



indifferent because life is the highest value in this world. Despite this, we should point out that the first day of the meetings was productive and took place in a friendly atmosphere. Delegates were interested in heated debates about different points of view. But this is only the beginning, the most interesting is waiting for us ahead!

In most cases, speaker's time had to be extended because representatives of countries asked many questions during the discussion to which they wanted to get constructive answers.
