Tver Model UN 2019

Human Rights Council

Meetings of the Human Rights Committee at the VII Tver International model UN continue. On the second day we were able to hear the positions of countries such as Libya, Saudi Arabia, the Russian Federation, Ukraine and France. Country representatives expressed their points of view about the situation and responded to questions of the Presidium and delegates. The delegate from Saudi Arabia was convinced that everything can be solved peacefully. The representative from the Russian Federation preferred to remain neutral, but said that her country was ready to provide any support to the civilian population. But the delegate from France said that the country did not consider Hezbollah as a terrorist organization.



Unfortunately, the trend of the past day continued and some diplomats behaved passively about the situation. But this did not prevent the development of events. Then formal debates began and three representatives from Germany, France and Saudi Arabia made their speeches. After it the delegate from Israel also initiated a desire to participate in the discussion. The delegate of Germany also put himself to the list of speakers. While heated debates diplomats actively asked questions. All were concerned about the request of Israel to provide their country with economic assistance, weapons, bombs, human resources. By the end of the second day of meetings, delegates had separated into 3 coalitions for writing draft resolutions.



The first coalition only consisted of Israel. Germany was ready to propose its own project. The third coalition included the delegates of all other countries.
